8 Week Program:

Jan 21st – Mar 17th

Destination Lessons:

Opening Day – Closing Day

Register one week prior to lesson

\$50 for half day

\$100 for a full day

No program on Christmas Day

Ski PE:

Opening Day – Closing Day

Register one week prior to lesson

\$40 for a full day lesson

Only for school groups

All pricing includes rentals, 2 hours lift ticket, volunteer ski instructors, and any additional adaptive equipment.

Your spot will not be set until all of your paperwork is submitted: 2019 Eagle Mount Application, a current Physician's Approval, Bridger Bowl Waiver, and Round House Rental Form (if needing to rent).

Eagle Mount's accountant will bill you or pay in advance. There are scholarships available.

Ski lessons and times

7 days a week – Morning lessons (10am-12pm) Afternoon lessons (1pm – 3pm) * 20 spots per time slot

Lunch is on participants/family own accord.

Clothing and Prep for Ski Day

Please prepare your participant to come to Bridger Bowl wearing proper ski clothing. Snow pants and jacket are ideal. Accessories needed are gloves, hats, and warm socks.

Directions to the Eagle Mount Ski Facility (aka 'The Ski Hut')

When you drive up to Bridger Bowl you'll continue left until you reach the building farthest to the left, left of the Bridger Lodge. Our facility is next to ski patrol.
